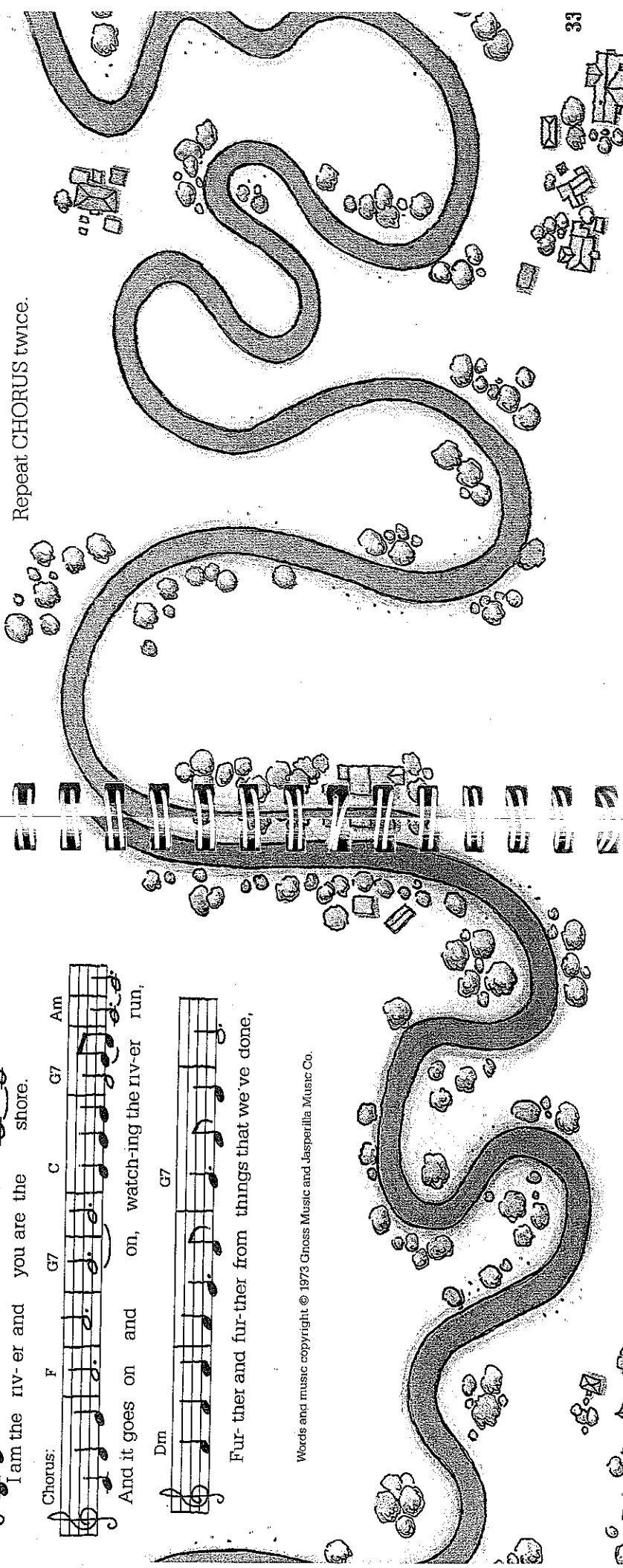
Leav-ing them one by one. And we have
